Starting June 7, 2020, C & W physicians and staff will be able to download the web-based Spectrum CW Antimicrobial Stewardship Program app on their phones. Information will be readily available with a few touches to view CW-specific guidelines, pathogens and antimicrobials.

The PHSA Antimicrobial Stewardship Program leaders and staff support physicians to identify and choose the right antibiotic at the right time with the right route for patients at BC Children's and Women's Hospital since 2012 with tremendous success. Antimicrobial Stewardship refers to a program or series of interventions to monitor and direct antimicrobial use at a health care institution.

The PHSA Antimicrobial Stewardship Program (AMS) leaders and staff would like to improve efficiency and effectiveness for physicians to choose the correct antibiotics using PHSA antibiotic treatment guidelines and bacterial sensitivities or antibiogram report. Presently, physicians must be close to a computer to look up treatment guidelines and antibiogram results in order to choose the correct antibiotic for their patient. On June 7, physicians and staff will be able to view CW-specific guidelines, pathogens and antimicrobials with a few easy clicks on their phone.
